



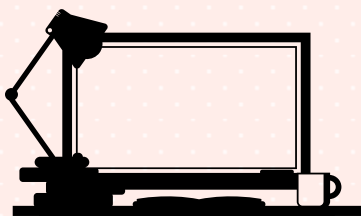

If you need assistance with research, accessing library materials, or have any questions, you are encouraged to use the Ask a Librarian service. It will connect you with a University Librarian who can assist you.

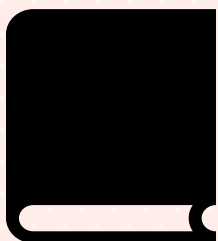

Electronic reserves can be accessed 24/7. The Course Reserves unit is currently accepting requests for the Fall semester.

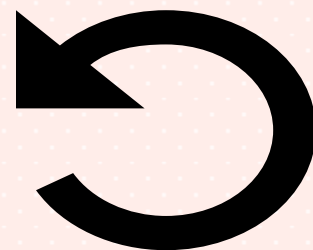
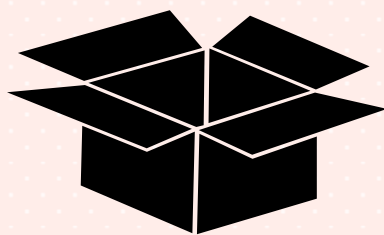
